



## **IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

The Zuni Incident Command ***will lift*** the 57-Hour Weekend Curfew **effective, Friday, January 1, 2021**. There will be no EXTENDED weekend curfews for the month of January 2021.

Keep in mind, if there is an increase in COVID-19 positive cases, the 57-Hour weekend curfew **will be** reinstated through the approval of an amended tribal resolution. We must continue to remain vigilant in defeating COVID-19 by consistently practicing all safety precautionary measures to include: social distancing, use of face masks when in public, frequent handwashing/sanitizing, disinfecting/sanitizing high touch surfaces, limit in state and out of state travel and avoid large gatherings of 5 or more. Please stay home as much as possible.

### ***Continued Mitigation Efforts:***

- Daily evening curfew - 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM
- Checkpoints will remain in effect – east/west side entrances of Hwy 53
- All local stores/businesses may remain open up until 7 pm daily.

Violation(s) of the directions outlined on the Zuni Tribal Resolution No. M70-2020-P062 may cause individuals to be charged with Public Nuisance (4-4-120), Failure to Disperse (4-4-96) and other charges as the facts may merit.
